

**Sarnia Yacht Club

The Sarnia Yacht Club is member operated club on the shores of Lake Huron one hour north of Detroit and three hours west of Toronto. The club has operated a sailing school for many years and wishes to build on the excellence of services provided to many local children and adults. The sailing school has a fleet of Opti Prams (11), Club 420 (10) Laser II (3), A11 Trainers (6) and coach boats (6). Registration is about 150 children and 20 adults.

**JOB SUMMARY:**

The position requires professionally organized skills necessary to operate a seasonal junior and adult sail training program. An active role instructing students will be required.

**SUPERVISION RECEIVED:**

Report to Sail Training Director.

**SUPERVISION EXERCISED:**

Supervision of all instructional staff (up to six summer staff).

**COMPENSATION:**

\$600 - \$650/week based on experience and qualifications.

**TIME REQUIREMENTS:**

Commencing on or about June 25<sup>th</sup>, 2008 and ending on or about September 1<sup>st</sup> 2008.

**GENERAL DUTIES:**

- Be responsible for the daily operations and tasks associated with all sail training programs for juniors aged 8 - 17 yrs and adults taking beginner/immediate sail training.
- Create, promote and maintain curriculum, help with the hiring and training of new instructors, and assist with general maintenance projects of sail training owned equipment.
- Have demonstrated ability to effectively communicate with junior and adult students, parents, club directors and members.
- Assist with management of the facilities, capital acquisitions and improvements.
- Enforce policies of SYC, and if necessary default to SYC Sail Training Director.

Program features include:

- Eight week summer programs.

**EXPERIENCE:**

- Minimum 3 years working as an instructor in a sailing program.
- CYA Red Level qualifications (or equal US Sailing qualifications).
- Experience with general boat maintenance.
- Possess excellent communication, organization, and mediation skills.
- Current First Aid, CPR Certification and PCOC.
- Individuals should be enthusiastic, diplomatic, flexible, trustworthy, self-motivated, creative and able to take the initiative to complete tasks as assigned.
