**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association will apply and will be posted on the Official Notice Board
- 1.3 The class rules of the participating classes will apply. Boats in the 420 class may use any recognized 420 hull form and the standard club training rig (with non-tapered mast) and shall have a minimum weight of 100 kg fully rigged for sailing and in dry condition but without sails and personal equipment.
- 1.4 The preamble to Part 4 and rule 40.1 is changed to require adequate personal buoyancy to be worn at all times while afloat except when changing clothing.  
  
Racing rule A4 and 35 will be changed to allow boats to be scored DNS and DNF in certain circumstances. Rule 60.1(a) will be changed to restrict boats protesting boats in certain circumstances. Rule 66 will change the time limit for delivering a request to reopen a hearing. Appendix P will apply and be changed to modify rule P2.2 and delete rule P2.3. Other rules may be changed by the sailing instructions. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.
- 1.5 Rule G1.1(b) will not apply. This changes rule 77.

**2 ADVERTISING**

Advertising will be permitted under Category C in accord with ISAF Regulation 20.

**3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 Entry to the CYA 16 and Under Eastern Championships and the CYA 15 and Under Eastern Championships is restricted to sailors who are Canadian Citizens or landed immigrants permanently residing in Canada. Entry to the Fogh Boorman Regatta and the Ontario Sailing 13 and Under Championships, Ontario 16 and Under Double Handed Championships and Ontario 16 and Under Single Handed Championships is open to all sailors. Each sailor must provide a copy of his or her birth certificate or other proof of citizenship at the time of registration. All above Championships and the Fogh Boorman will be run in tandem on the same racecourses.  
  
For those pre-registering, a photocopy of proof must be included with the registration.  
The regatta is open to all boats of the Laser, Laser Radial, Laser II, Byte, 29er, Optimist and Club 420.
- 3.2 To be eligible for prizes in the CYA 16 and Under Eastern Intermediates, competitors must be 16 years of age as of December 31, 2006.
- 3.3 To be eligible for prizes in the Ontario Sailing 16, competitors must be 16 years of age or less as of December 31, 2006.
- 3.4 Competitors in the Optimist class will be required to show proof of age. The Optimist class will compete together and be scored in separate fleets as follows: Red 13–15 years of age, Blue 11–12 years of age, White 10 years of age and under as of December 31, 2006. If a sufficient number of novice Optimist competitors register, there will be a separate Green fleet.
- 3.5 Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form and sending it, together with the required fee, to RHYC by July 7, 2006. A signed waiver form must be received by the close of registration. Competitors are also required to sign the CYA Youth Code of Conduct, copies of which will be available at the registration desk.
- 3.6 Late entries will be accepted under the condition that the required late fee has been paid.
- 3.7 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply: Events for classes for which there are fewer than three entries by July 7, 2006 may be cancelled and the entry fees returned.

#### **4 FEES**

4.1 Required fees (includes clinic, lunch 3 days and dinner on Saturday) are as follows:

4.2 Other fees:

5.1 Registration:

Thursday July 13 from 1830 to 2000 hrs  
Friday, July 14 from 1830 to 2000 hrs  
Saturday, July 15 from 0800 to 0945 hrs

5.2 A competitor's briefing will be held at 1000 hrs on Saturday, July 15.

5.3 Dates of racing:

5.4 Number of races:

All classes (except Opti Green)	7	4 maximum
Opti Green	32	No Maximum

5.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Saturday is 1100 hrs. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Sunday is 1030 hrs. On Sunday, no warning signal will be made after 1400 hrs.

#### **6 MEASUREMENTS**

Each boat may be required to produce a valid measurement certificate.

#### **7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available after 1830 hrs on Thursday July 13 at the registration desk.

#### **8 RACING AREAS**

Racing will take place in the waters of Hamilton Harbour. Racing for the Optimist Green fleet may take place inside the break wall if conditions warrant.

#### **9 THE COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward or windward/leeward/triangle.

#### **10 SCORING**

10.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.2 (a) When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

#### **11 SUPPORT BOATS**

Team leaders, coaches and other support personnel (including parents of competitors) intending to be on the water during the regatta shall register with the organizing authority. Support boats will be assigned a berth or mooring area for the duration of

the regatta. Such berth or mooring is subject to the terms and conditions for all boats using RHYC controlled facilities.

## **12 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## **13 PRIZES**

- 13.1 The Fogh-Boorman regatta is an open regatta and awards will be presented to the boats finishing first, second and third in each class including all optimist classes (Red, Blue, White and Green) with 5 or more boats registered.
- 13.2 OS Championship awards will be presented to the boats finishing first, second and third in each class provided that they meet the entry requirements, with 5 or more boats registered
- 13.3 CYA Championship Awards will be presented to the boats finishing first, second and third provided that they meet the entry requirements, and there are 5 or more boats registered.
- 13.4 The Fogh Boorman trophy will be awarded to the best overall Optimist sailor.

## **14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **15 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per event or the equivalent.

## **16 HOSPITALITY**

Meal packages (box lunch Friday, Saturday and Sunday and dinner on Saturday) for team leaders, parents and other support personnel may be purchased at the registration desk at a cost of \$45.00. Breakfast will be available both days in the Evergreen Lounge beginning at 0800 hrs. Meal packages must be ordered before close of registration Friday July 15.
