P.C.Y.C. places a strong emphasis on our students overall learning experience in a very SAFE environment with a focus on FUN for all.

Salaries are consistent with OSA guidelines, commensurate with experience and qualifications. Evening Adult classes will be paid on an hourly basis with assignments rotated amongst instructors.
